## 2 Health - Consent Required for Blood Donations by Minors

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from taking a donation of blood from a minor
- 4 before the person receives the written consent of a parent or legal guardian of the
- 5 minor; providing a penalty for a violation of this Act; repealing existing provisions
- 6 related to the consent required for blood donations by minors; and generally
- 7 relating to the consent required for blood donations by minors.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor who is at least 17 years old,
- 4 without the consent of a parent, may give blood to a program that:
- 5 (1) Is voluntary;
- 6 (2) Does not pay money for the blood; and
- 7 (3) Is approved by:
- 8 (i) The American Association of Blood Banks; or
- 9 (ii) The American Red Cross.]

- 11 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT TAKE A DONATION OF BLOOD FROM A MINOR UNTIL
- 12 THE PERSON RECEIVES THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN
- 13 OF THE MINOR.
- 14 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT
- 15 TO A CIVIL FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 17 July 1, 1997.
