BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 14 15 21-104. 16 (a) The Board of Trustees consists of the following 14 16 trustees: (1) the Secretary of Budget and Management, ex officio; 17

(2) the State Comptroller, ex officio;

(3) the State Superintendent of Schools, ex officio;

(4) the State Treasurer, ex officio, who may appoint a deputy treasurer as

2 (6) two THREE trustees who are members or retirees of the Correctional 3 Officers' Retirement System, the Employees' Pension System, the Employees' 4 Retirement System, the Judges' Retirement System, the Legislative Pension Plan, the 5 Local Fire and Police System, or the Law Enforcement Officers' Pension Plan, fonly one 6 of whom may SHALL be OF WHOM ONE IS a retiree of any of those State systems at the 7 time of election under subsection (b) of this section and neither NONE of whom may be 8 an employee of the State Retirement Agency; 9 (7) two THREE trustees who are members or retirees of the Teachers'
