## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Computer Information Science and Engineering Graduates - Loan Forgiveness Study

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Commission to study a program of loan assistance
  4 repayment for graduates of Maryland colleges and universities in the areas of
  5 computer information science and engineering who agree to work for Maryland
  6 companies; providing for the membership of the Commission; specifying that the
  7 Department of Higher Education will provide staff services for the Commission;
  8 requiring the Commission to submit a certain report by a certain date; and generally
  9 relating to a Commission to study a program of loan assistance repayment for
  10 graduates of Maryland colleges and universities in the areas of computer
- information science and engineering who agree to work for a Maryland company.
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That:
- 14 (a) There is a Commission to study a program to assist in the repayment of
- 15 student loans owed by graduates of Maryland colleges and universities with degrees in the
- $16\,$  areas of computer information science and engineering who agree to work for a Maryland
- 17 company.
- 18 (b) Funds provided by the State for the program shall be matched by the 19 employing company.
- 20 (c) The Commission consists of eight members. Of the members:
- 21 (1) One shall be a member of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the
- 22 President of the Senate;
- 23 (2) One shall be a member of the House of Delegates, appointed by the
- 24 Speaker of the House;
- 25 (3) One shall be the Secretary of Business and Economic Development, or
- 26 the Secretary's designee;
- 27 (4) One shall be the Secretary of Higher Education, or the Secretary's
- 28 designee;
- 29 (5) Two shall be the presidents of the two public institutions of higher
- 30 education in the State that graduate the most computer information science and
- 31 engineering students, or the Presidents' designees;

- 1 (6) One shall be a representative of the business community, appointed by 2 the Governor; and
- 3 (7) One shall be a representative of a Maryland technology council, 4 appointed by the Governor.
- 5 (d) The Department of Higher Education shall provide staff services for the 6 Commission.
- 7 (e) By December 15, 1997, the Commission shall submit a report, which shall 8 include a legislative proposal for a pilot program, to the Governor and, subject to § 9 2-1312 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly of Maryland.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 July 1, 1997.
