1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Laws - Changing Lanes - Lane Must be Clear

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision in order to prohibit the driver of a vehicle
- 4 from changing lanes or moving from a shoulder or bikeway into a lane until the lane
- 5 is clear so that the vehicle may enter and occupy the lane without danger to any
- 6 other vehicle.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Transportation
- 15 21-309.
- 16 (b) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable entirely within a single lane
- 17 and may not be moved from that lane or moved from a shoulder or bikeway into a lane
- 18 until the [driver has determined that it is safe to do so] LANE IS CLEAR SO THAT THE
- 19 VEHICLE CHANGING LANES MAY ENTER AND OCCUPY THE LANE WITHOUT DANGER
- 20 TO ANY OTHER VEHICLE.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 1997.
