1 AN ACT concerning

2 Baltimore City - Property Owners - Waiver of Rights

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the applicable enforcement agency in Baltimore City to
- 4 enter onto certain property to take certain actions if a property owner does not
- 5 comply with a citation order to correct certain violations within a certain period of
- 6 time; providing that the property owner is liable for certain costs; and generally
- 7 relating to the right of the applicable enforcement agency in Baltimore City to enter
- 8 onto certain property to take certain actions under certain circumstances.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Real Property**

- 18 (A) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE APPLICABLE ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY
- 19 ENTER ONTO ANY PROPERTY THAT IS ABANDONED OR BOARDED UP OR IF A
- 20 HOUSING CODE VIOLATION EXISTS ON THE PROPERTY, TO EITHER DEMOLISH THE
- 21 PROPERTY OR TO CORRECT THE HOUSING CODE VIOLATION WITHOUT ISSUING
- 22 PRIOR NOTICE OR OBTAINING A WARRANT FOR THE ENTRY IF:
- 23 (1) A CITATION HAS ALREADY BEEN ISSUED TO THE PROPERTY
- 24 OWNER; AND
- 25 (2) THE PROPERTY OWNER HAS FAILED TO RESPOND TO THE CITATION
- 26 WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE CITATION WAS ISSUED.
- 27 (B) THE PROPERTY OWNER SHALL BE LIABLE FOR THE COST OF THE
- 28 CORRECTION OF THE HOUSING CODE VIOLATION OR THE COST OF DEMOLISHING
- 29 THE PROPERTY.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

2 October 1, 1997.
