### A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Maryland Higher Education Commission - Duties

3 FOR the purpose of specifying which proposals for capital projects and improvements for

- 4 certain nonpublic institutions of higher education the Maryland Higher Education
- 5 Commission is required to review.

## 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### 13 Article - Education

14 11-105.

15 (h) (1) On or before a date set by the Commission, each of the following

16 governing boards and agencies shall submit to the Commission its annual operating

17 budget requests and proposals for capital projects, by constituent institutions for the next

18 fiscal year:

19	(i) The Board of Regents of the University of Maryland System;
20	(ii) The Board of Regents of Morgan State University;
21	(iii) The Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland;
22	(iv) The Maryland Higher Education Loan Corporation;
23 24 of 1965; and	(v) The State Advisory Council for Title I of the Higher Education Act
25	(vi) The Board of Trustees of Baltimore City Community College.

(2) In consultation with the Department of Budget and Management, the
 Commission shall present to the Governor, on or before a date set by the Governor, and
 simultaneously submit a copy to the General Assembly, a consolidated operating and
 capital budget for higher education that includes the operating and capital budget
 requests of the governing boards and institutions listed in paragraph (1) of this
 subsection, the operating budget request of the Commission, a report on the current
 funding of the adopted sets of peer institutions, and recommendations regarding the
 funding of higher education.

9 (3) In cooperation with the Department of Budget and Management, and 10 without affecting the authority or responsibility of the Department under the State 11 Finance and Procurement Article, the Commission shall:

(i) Review proposals for capital projects and improvements proposed
by the public institutions of higher education in this State, and by THE nonpublic
institutions of higher education THAT ARE MEMBERS OF THE MARYLAND
INDEPENDENT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY ASSOCIATION AND THAT ARE seeking
State funds for capital projects and improvements; and

(ii) Develop and submit to the Governor and the General Assemblyrecommendations as to these projects, which shall be consistent with the plan providedfor in this section.

(4) In submitting recommendations pursuant to paragraph (2) of this
subsection, the Commission shall comment on the overall level of funding for higher
education and may comment regarding funding priorities among segments of higher
education and, within public senior higher education, among institutions. In reviewing the
various budgets and submitting recommendations thereon, the Commission:

(i) May not require, of any segment or institution, a detailed budget
presentation that tends to duplicate other presentations required in the budget process;
and

(ii) As to the funding priority of any institution, may comment only onthe entity as a whole and not on any separate unit of the institution.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 31 October 1, 1997.

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
