- 2 light wine, or beer, wine and liquor license may not be issued except by way of renewal
- 3 [in Baltimore City] to a person, corporation, or limited liability company holding an
- 4 alcoholic beverage license in any other state.
- 5 (3) IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, A CLASS A OR CLASS D BEER, BEER AND
- 6 LIGHT WINE, OR BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE MAY NOT BE ISSUED, EXCEPT BY
- 7 WAY OF RENEWAL, TO A PERSON, CORPORATION, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY
