House Bill 141 (Delegate Preis) Judiciary

Family Law - Applicability of the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children

This bill prohibits a sending agency from placing a child with a parent or other family member who resides outside the State, or with persons in the State who are permanent residents of another state, until every requirement specified in the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children is satisfied. The bill also requires that proper authorities be notified before the placement of a child.
