Economic Matters

Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation - Staggered Licensing

This departmental bill provides that the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation may determine that the occupational and/or professional licenses for accountants, architects, electricians, foresters, certified interior designers, landscape architects, pilots, plumbers, professional engineers, and professional land surveyors shall expire on a staggered basis.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Indeterminate. Absent a specific licensing plan, any potential effect on revenues and expenditures cannot reliably be determined at this time.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: The Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation has determined that the bill has no impact on small business (attached). Fiscal Services agrees with this assessment.
