Port of Baltimore and Related Waterways - Dredging Maintenance and Improvement - Joint Committee

This amended bill establishes a 16-member Joint Committee on Dredging Maintenance and Improvement of the Port of Baltimore and Related Waterways, with five additional ex officio members. The committee must examine and evaluate dredging strategies, and annually report and make recommendations on the issue to the Governor and the House Environmental Matters Committee and the Senate Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee. The Department of Legislative Reference and the Department of Fiscal Services will provide staff assistance to the committee.
