Highways - Harriet Tubman Memorial Bridge

This bill names the U.S. Route 50 bridge across the Nanticoke River the “Harriet Tubman Memorial Bridge”.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal increase in Transportation Trust Fund expenditures as discussed below. Revenues would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None. This bill would not directly affect small businesses.

Fiscal Analysis

State Expenditures: Although the bill does not require that signs be erected displaying the new name of the bridge, the State Highway Administration expects to incur this cost. Two signs would cost less than \$2,000. The funds would be provided by the Transportation Trust Fund.
