**Prince George's County Board of Education - Vacancy - Election of Members**

**PG 408-97**

---

This bill changes the method of filling a vacancy on the Prince George's County Board of Education. Under current law, the County Executive appoints a new member who serves the remainder of that term. Pursuant to this legislation, the individual filling the vacancy would serve only until a successor is elected and qualifies at a special election within one year after the date of vacancy or at the next congressional election.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** The cost of holding a special election to fill a vacancy on the Prince George's County Board of Education is assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing county resources.

**Small Business Effect:** None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
