House Bill 882 (Montgomery County and Prince George's County Delegations) Commerce and Government Matters

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Salary Schedules by Jurisdiction MC/PG 47-97

This bill requires the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) to establish a separate compensation and salary schedule for commission employees whose primary duties are performed in Montgomery County, Prince George's County, or equally divided between Montgomery and Prince George's counties.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Indeterminate effect on M-NCPPC's expenditures. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None. Small businesses would not be directly affected.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: M-NCPPC advises that establishing separate compensation and salary schedules for three groups of employees will complicate the current salary administration process and increase the commission's workload. However, without any supporting documentation from the commission, the effect, if any, on administrative expenditures cannot be reliably determined at this time. Likewise, any effect on personnel costs resulting from establishing three separate pay schedules cannot be reliably estimated at this time.
