House Bill 892 (Montgomery County and Prince George's County Delegations) Commerce and Government Matters

District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority - Bicounty Appointment Process MC/PG 2-97

This bill requires the Montgomery County Executive and the Prince George's County Executive to nominate to the Mayor of the District of Columbia an individual to fill a vacancy on the Board of Directors of the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority from a list submitted by the respective county legislative delegation. If the legislative delegations fail to submit a list of nominees to the county executives in a timely manner, the county executives may recommend any qualified individual to fill the vacancy.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Requiring the county executives of Montgomery and Prince George's counties to nominate an individual from a list submitted by the respective county legislative delegation would not affect either jurisdiction's finances.

Small Business Effect: None. This legislation does not directly affect small businesses.
