Maryland Traumatic Brain Injury and Spinal Cord Injury Advisory Board

This amended bill establishes a 13-member Maryland Traumatic Brain Injury and Spinal Cord Injury Advisory Board in the Division of Rehabilitation Services. The advisory board must investigate the needs of citizens with traumatic brain and spinal cord injuries and identify the gaps in services to citizens with such injuries. The advisory board must report to the General Assembly by January 31 of each year. The bill takes effect October 1, 1997 and sunsets September 30, 2002.
