## **Charitable Solicitation - Professional Solicitors**

This departmental bill provides that the Secretary of State may return a bond or irrevocable letter of credit filed by a person applying to register as a professional solicitor only if (1) three years have passed since the period to which the bond or letter applies and there is no pending claim; or (2) the registration period is over, all required accounting reports have been properly filed, and the Secretary of State is satisfied that the person is not in violation of the Maryland Charitable Solicitations Act.
