Garrett County - Counsel to the County Commissioners - Duties

This bill repeals the requirement that the County Attorney in Garrett County serve as legal counsel to the Garrett County Sheriff. The bill is effective July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Currently, the County Attorney does not act as legal counsel to the Sheriff.

Small Business Effect: None. Since the Sheriff currently uses a private attorney as legal counsel, the bill would not directly affect small businesses.
