Condominiums - Parking for the Handicapped - Council of Unit Owners

This amended bill authorizes a council of condominium unit owners to designate parking for the handicapped, notwithstanding any provision in the declarations, bylaws, or rules and regulations of a condominium.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Assuming that the Consumer Protection Division will receive fewer than 50 complaints per year stemming from this bill, existing resources should be adequate to handle any additional workload.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None. This bill would not directly affect small businesses.
