Natural Resources - Authority Over Abandoned Vessels - Delegation to Local Jurisdictions

This amended bill provides that the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) may only delegate authority for the removal and disposal of abandoned vessels to a local jurisdiction that consents to the delegation.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None, as discussed below.

Small Business Effect: None. Small businesses would not be directly affected.

Fiscal Analysis

Background: DNR previously had an abandoned and derelict boat crew that was abolished as part of the recent departmental reorganization.

State Expenditures: Currently, counties receive grants as needed from the State to remove and dispose of abandoned vehicles in waterways. Approximately \$300,000 was budgeted during fiscal 1997 to cover boat and debris removal, most of which went to counties as grants; this amount has been entirely encumbered. During fiscal 1996, \$600,000 was spent on these projects. DNR advises that this legislation codifies current practice, and therefore these funds would continue.

Local Effect: Local governments would continue to receive State grant funds for these activities if they consent to the delegation of authority.
