House Bill 243 (Chairman, Environmental Matters Committee) (Departmental - Natural Resources)

**Environmental Matters** 

Fish - Limited Entry to the Commercial Fishery - Seasons, Gear, and Catch Limits

This departmental bill repeals the sunset date of April 1, 1999 for the limitations and restrictions on commercial fishing licenses.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** State revenues from commercial fishing license fees will continue to be limited beginning in FY 2000 as discussed below.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** The Department of Natural Resources has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small businesses (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

**State Revenues:** State revenues due to commercial fisheries license fees will be maintained at the current limited level (approximately \$1 million per year) under the bill beginning in fiscal 2000, so long as no fee increases are instituted.
