Life and Health Insurance and Annuities - Rebates

This enrolled bill specifies that educational materials, promotional materials, or articles of merchandise that cost less than \$10 (adjusted for inflation) are excepted from the prohibition against a person offering, promising, or giving any valuable consideration not specified in a life or health insurance or annuity contract, regardless of whether a policy is purchased.
