#### Migratory Waterfowl Stamp - Migratory Waterfowl Advisory Committee

This amended bill names the advisory committee on waterfowl issues the "Migratory Waterfowl Advisory Committee" and decreases the number of members on the committee from 13 to 9. The committee must advise the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) on the expenditures of funds from the sale of State migratory waterfowl stamps, and recommendations to the Migratory Waterfowl Advisory Committee on policy, regulations, and legislation.
