House Bill 1273 (Delegate M. Burns) Appropriations

Maryland Food Center Authority - Repayment of Moneys from the State

This bill repeals an obsolete provision of law requiring the Governor to include \$10,000 in the 1968 budget for the Maryland Food Center Authority to use in covering its start-up costs. The \$10,000 is required to be repaid to the State of Maryland from the proceeds of the authority's first bond sale.
