Senate Bill 553 (Senator Haines) (Carroll County Senate Delegation) Economic and Environmental Affairs

Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages (Special and Temporary Licenses - Fees)

This bill increases the one-day license fee for a special Class C beer or beer and wine license in Carroll County from \$10 to \$50.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Carroll County revenues would increase by \$1,200 annually. No effect on expenditures.

Small Business Effect: Minimal. Although the bill increases the fee for one-day Class C beer or beer and wine licenses, it would not change the competitive marketplace in Carroll County.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Revenues: The Carroll County Board of License Commissioners issues approximately 30 special and temporary alcoholic beverages licenses annually. The bill increases the daily license fee by \$40, meaning revenues would increase by \$1,200 annually.
