## **Child Abuse - Out of Court Statements - Nurses**

This amended bill allows an out of court statement by a nurse in a proceeding for certain child abuse violations to be admissible if the statement was made to and is offered by the nurse lawfully acting within the scope of the individual's profession.

Further, the bill repeals the requirement that the out of court statements be made to and be offered by specified individuals who possess occupational licenses.
