House Bill 694 (Delegate Cryor, *et al.*) Judiciary

Adoption and Guardianship Proceedings - Appointment of Counsel

This bill requires a court to appoint separate counsel to represent an individual who is the subject of a termination of parental rights proceeding in which the State is petitioning for guardianship until a final judgment of adoption is entered. Current law requires an appointment of counsel only if the termination of parental rights is involuntary.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The departments of social services already assume responsibility for legal representation during applicable proceedings. Therefore, this bill codifies existing practice.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
