St. Mary's County - Subdivision of Land - Validity of Specified Deeds

This amended bill provides that deeds, creating subdivisions of not more than five lots, executed or recorded before August 1, 1990 (December 1, 1985 in critical areas) in St. Mary's County are granted the validity and effectiveness of those executed or recorded before June 1, 1974.

The bill is effective June 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. St. Mary's County's Planning and Zoning Department's workload would not be significantly affected.

Small Business Effect: Minimal. Small businesses owning property in violation of St. Mary's County's subdivision laws would benefit from the elimination of the requirement to comply with the county's subdivision laws.
