Montgomery County - Alcoholic Beverages (CAT License - Termination Date Removed) MC 705-97

This bill removes the September 30, 1997 sunset date for caterers' licenses in Montgomery County. The bill is effective July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Montgomery County would continue to receive \$1,250 in license fees from a single caterer's (CAT) license.

Small Business Effect: Small businesses that hold a caterer's license would continue their operations without change and continue to pay the \$1,250 license fee.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Revenues: Currently, Montgomery County issues one caterer's (CAT) license annually. Since the legislation removes the sunset date for the license, the county will continue to receive the \$1,250 license fee.
