## Vehicle Laws - Display of Amber Flashing Lights - Community Patrols

This amended bill authorizes "Citizens on Patrol" or other community watch group to display flashing amber lights while on patrol in the community if allowed by the local police department. The lights must be extinguished if so instructed by a uniformed police officer. A local law enforcement agency may require that the group conducting the patrol display an identifying sign while the amber flashing light is displayed.
