House Bill 235 (Delegate C. Davis, *et al.*) Environmental Matters

Health - Information Privacy - Disclosure of Medical Records

This bill repeals certain existing law circumstances under which a health care provider may disclose the medical records of a patient without the patient's consent. A health care provider is prohibited from disclosing directory information about a patient without the authorization of the patient, unless otherwise permitted by law. The bill also specifies that the date-of-birth information collected by the Health Care Access and Cost Commission (HCACC) for the Maryland medical database may only contain the month and year of birth. HCACC may not collect patient encounter data for which the patient elects to self-pay.
