Legal Holidays - Memorial Day - Day of Observance

This bill specifies that Memorial Day will be observed as a State legal holiday on May 30. Under current law, Memorial Day is observed as a State legal holiday on the day designated for observance by the United States Congress. Traditionally, Congress has designated the last Monday in May as the day of observance for Memorial Day.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. State agencies already budget for Memorial Day, regardless of when it is observed.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None. This bill would not directly affect small businesses.
