Higher Education - Enforcement Powers

This amended bill authorizes the Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC) to administer oaths and issue subpoenas. If a person fails to comply with a subpoena issued by MHEC, the circuit courts are authorized to compel compliance with the subpoena, quash the subpoena, or amend the terms of the subpoena.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Potential minimal increase in general fund revenues to the extent that the bill's provisions improve MHEC's ability to enforce compliance with regulations and standards. Expenditures would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
