House Bill 1335 (Delegate Parker, *et al.*)
Appropriations

State Personnel - Appeals of Disciplinary Actions

This bill provides that in the case of an appeal of disciplinary action related to an arrest, the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) must schedule a hearing of the appeal within 30 days after final adjudication of the charges against the employee. Under current law, all hearings of appeals of disciplinary actions must be scheduled within 30 days of OAH receiving the appeal.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill delays the time period for scheduling hearings in a limited number of cases, but does not alter the number of cases heard by the OAH. OAH already has the discretion to grant postponements of appeals upon request of one of the parties.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None. This bill would not directly affect small businesses.
