Senate Bill 915 (Senator McFadden) Economic and Environmental Affairs

## **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages (Executive Director and Deputy)**

This bill requires the Executive Director and the Deputy Executive Director of the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners to be bona fide residents of the city. After appointment, if either official ceases to be a resident, that official's tenure is terminated and the position is deemed vacant. The bill also changes the position titles for the executive secretary and deputy executive secretary for the board to executive director and deputy executive director, respectively.

The bill is effective June 1, 1997.
