Public School Property - Possession of Portable Pager

This amended bill allows students to possess portable pagers on school property if the pagers are contained in vehicles that are on public school property and are not found to be connected with criminal activity.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Local finances would not be affected by providing an additional exemption to the law prohibiting the possession of portable pagers on school property.

Small Business Effect: None. Small businesses are not directly affected.
