Task Force to Review the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights and the Police Training Commission Act

This bill establishes a 15-member Task Force to Review the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights and the Police Training Commission. The bill specifies the issues that must be assessed by the task force. Staffing will be provided by the Department of Legislative Reference. The task force must issue its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly by December 15, 1997.

The bill is effective July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. It is assumed that task force members would be eligible for expense reimbursements according to the standard State travel regulations. Expense reimbursements would depend upon the time, location, and frequency of the task force's meetings. It is expected that reimbursements could be handled with the existing resources of the Governor's Office and the governmental entities represented on the task force. Staffing would be provided with the existing budgeted resources of the Department of Legislative Reference.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
