## **FISCAL NOTE**

House Bill 1366 (Washington County Delegation) Judiciary

## **Washington County Gaming Commission - Membership**

This bill repeals the prohibition against certain members of the Washington County Gaming Commission from serving on the board of directors or as an officer of any nonprofit organization (qualified under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code). The bill requires a commission member to file with the board a disclosure of any affiliation as a member of a board of directors or as an officer of a nonprofit organization. The bill extends the term of a commission member from two to three years and specifies that a member continues to serve only until the member's term expires, rather than until a successor is appointed. A member who serves an unexpired term for not more than one year may be appointed to serve an additional term.

The bill takes effect July 1, 1997.
