## State Board of Pharmacy - Issuance of Permits - Dialysis Drugs and Devices

This bill updates and alters provisions in existing law relating to the issuance of permits by the State Board of Pharmacy to distribute dialysis drugs and devices to the homes of dialysis patients.

The bill will take effect June 1, 1997.
