Senate Bill 616 (Senator Collins) (Baltimore County Administration) Economic and Environmental Affairs

Board of Community College Trustees for Baltimore County - Membership

This bill increases the number of members on the Board of Community College Trustees for Baltimore County from 11 to 15. The bill requires that one member be selected from the county at large and two be selected from each of the seven council districts. Under current law, four members are selected from the county at large and one is selected from each of the seven council districts.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Baltimore County expenditures could increase by \$3,300 in FY 1998. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None. Small businesses are not directly affected.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: Board members serve without compensation but are entitled to receive expense reimbursements. The fiscal 1997 community college budget includes \$6,000 for travel reimbursements and \$3,000 for telephone expenses for board members, or \$818 per member. Adding four additional members could increase Baltimore County expenditures by \$3,272 annually.
