Homicide - Victim Impact Statements - Changes

This bill provides that a personal representative, guardian, or family member of a victim of a homicide may update or otherwise change the victim impact statement throughout all sentencing and postsentencing procedures. Under current law, a personal representative, guardian, committee, or family member may provide victim impact statement information for a presentence investigation.
