House Bill 347 (Delegate Walkup)
Judiciary

Kent County - Gaming - Regulation

This bill increases the number of multiple gaming device permits which may be issued to an organization in a year from 2 to 12, and specifies that organizations, as well as persons, may not be compensated for managing or operating any authorized gaming activity.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Kent County does not charge a fee for multiple gaming permits.

Small Business Effect: Potential meaningful impact on small businesses providing certain gaming services. The bill prohibits an organization from being compensated for managing or operating any authorized gaming activity. Thus, small businesses providing such services in Kent County could realize revenue reductions.
