**Business Occupations - State Board of Cosmetologists - Membership**

---

This enrolled bill alters the membership of the State Board of Cosmetologists by increasing the number of licensed cosmetologists on the board from three to four, and by including one member affiliated with a private cosmetology school as an educator or an owner. This increases the total membership of the board from five to seven members.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Any increase in expense reimbursements and postage costs associated with two additional members would be minimal and absorbable within existing resources.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** None. Altering the membership of the State Board of Cosmetologists would not directly affect small business.
