House Bill 897 (Montgomery County and Prince George's County Delegations)
Commerce and Government Matters

Prince George's County - Zoning Matters - Citizens' Referendum
MC/PG 14-97

This bill allows Prince George's County citizens to petition to referendum any comprehensive zoning, general or master plan, subdivision or zoning ordinance amendment, or other ordinance of general legislative effect adopted by the Prince George's County Council and affecting the Prince George's County portion of the Maryland-Washington District. The bill also outlines various procedural elements of how such a petition and referendum would be administered.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Any costs associated with certifying signatures or educating voters about petition issues could be handled with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: None. This bill would not directly affect small businesses.
