House Bill 1227 (Delegate Rosenberg, *et al.*) Environmental Matters

Tobacco Products - Sales to Minors - Enforcement Exception to Prohibition

This bill provides that minors may purchase or attempt to purchase tobacco products for the purpose of monitoring compliance with laws regarding sales of tobacco products. It applies to minors purchasing or attempting to purchase tobacco products under the direction of law enforcement personnel, personnel of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene, personnel of local health departments, or agents of any of these organizations.
