Motor Vehicle License Plates

This joint resolution requests the Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA) to study the feasibility and advisability of implementing a program for regular replacement of vehicle license plates that includes design and color changes, including consideration of the costs and benefits of such a program.

The MVA is required to submit the results of the study to the House Ways and Means Committee, the Senate Finance Committee, and the Department of State Police by January 1, 1998.
