Domestic Abuse - Duties of Law Enforcement Officers

This bill requires a law enforcement officer to accompany a domestic abuse complainant/victim to the family home to remove the medicine and medical devices of the complainant or any child in the care of the complainant.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill codifies existing practices of the State Police.

Local Effect: None. The bill's requirements can be handled with existing budgeted resources of local law enforcement.

Small Business Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
