Task Force to Study the Maryland Child Support Guidelines to Ensure Appropriate Child Support Awards and the Feasibility of Child Support Cost of Living Adjustments

This bill establishes a 15-member Task Force to Study the Maryland Child Support Guidelines to Ensure Appropriate Child Support Awards and the Feasibility of Child Support Cost of Living Adjustments. Staff for the task force is to be provided by the Department of Human Resources. The task force is required to submit a report to the Governor and the General Assembly by June 1, 1998.

The bill takes effect July 1, 1997. The task force sunsets on June 1, 1998.
