## **Real Property - Baltimore, Cecil, Charles, Dorchester,** Washington, and Worcester Counties - Recordation

This enrolled bill provides that recordation of instruments by the clerk of the circuit court affecting property may be done prior to the transfer of the property on the assessment records in Baltimore, Cecil, Charles, Dorchester, Washington, and Worcester counties. It eliminates the requirement that an individual in one of these counties must visit the county property assessment office to have a deed reviewed and stamped before it is recorded by the clerk of the circuit court.
