Election Laws - Reports - Members of the General Assembly

This bill requires members and members-elect of the General Assembly and their political committees, to report contributions received and expenditures made from the end of the last report up to the first day of the regular session of the General Assembly. The report must be filed by the 15th day after the start of a regular session of the General Assembly.
