House Bill 908 (Montgomery County and Prince George's County Delegations) Ways and Means

Montgomery County and Prince George's County - School Board Election Districts Boundaries
MC/PG 5-97

The bill alters the boundaries of the school board election districts for the election of members to the Board of Education for Montgomery County and Prince George's County. The bill removes a precinct in Prince George's County and adds two precincts to Montgomery County.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: There would be a minimal increase in administrative costs for Montgomery County to realign school board election district maps, which could be absorbed within existing resources. Prince George's County election costs could decrease by a minimal amount. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.

Fiscal Analysis

Additional Comments: At the November 1995 municipal election, residents of Takoma Park decided to place the entire city in Montgomery County, effective July 1, 1997. This legislation adjusts the school board election districts in both Montgomery and Prince George's counties to reflect the boundary alteration.
